HOW DO I MAKE IT TO LAS VEGAS?



1. Enter and win a local Singles Tournament in your specific skill level category (and format) and advance to the March 2019 APA Spring Singles Regional.
2. Win at the Regional Singles Tournament in your specific skill level category (and format) and receive travel assistance and hotel accommodations at the Westgate Las Vegas Resort and Casino. You will compete with other players in your specific skill level category (and format) for lots of cash, and one of eight World titles offered in the \$600,000 APA Poolplayers Championship.

APA players who are on an active 8-Ball team, and have at least ten (10) lifetime 8-Ball matches in their record (at the time that they register) may register for the 8-Ball Mega Singles Tournament ... APA players who are on an active 9-Ball team (with 10 lifetime 9-Ball scores in their record) may register for the 9-Ball Mega Singles Tournament. All 10 scores must have occurred over the past two years.

WHO CAN REGISTER?

You must pre-register and pre-pay online using PayPal. Look for fliers in your team envelope around the middle of the session notifying you of open registration dates. HOW TO REGISTER?

Our 9-Ball Mega Singles Tournament will be played on Saturday, December 1st (12Noon) at The New Green Room, located at 2401 North Point Blvd. in Dundalk, Maryland. Doors will open at 11:00am. Check-in is between 11:00am and 11:45am, with matches beginning at 12Noon. Players will be seeded by skill level if possible.
Our 8-Ball Mega Singles Tournament will be played on Saturday, December 1st (6:00pm) at The New Green Room. Check-in is between 5:00pm and 5:45pm, with matches beginning at 6:00pm. Players will be seeded by skill level if possible.

WHEN AND WHERE?

SL CHANGES?

You will play in the event at the skill level you possess at the time we receive your registration, or at the time we process paperwork for the event; whichever is higher! If an increase in skill level places you in another bracket, you will not be disqualified; you will simply be assigned to play in the proper SL bracket in which you belong (if possible).

ELIGIBILITY?

Once qualified, to maintain eligibility you must remain on an active team within the same format (each session) until completion of the APA Poolplayers Championships.
