APA 9-BALL SCOTCH DOUBLES LEAGUE INFORMATION

(For the Spring, Summer, and Fall 2019 Sessions)

In addition to our 6-person 8-Ball Scotch Doubles League, we have introduced 6-Person 9-Ball Scotch Doubles Leagues locally. A 5-Match alternating format of 9-Ball Singles and 9-Ball Scotch Doubles, starting with Singles. ALL team members can now play every week, if they choose! The 2020 Scotch Doubles 9-Ball Vegas Qualifier will be held at The New Green Room in February of 2020. The winning team will advance to Las Vegas where they will be awarded 3 slots in the APA 9-Ball Doubles Championship! - **6-person teams. \$45/team (\$7.50/player). APA Handicapped.**
- EVERYONE can play each week, if they choose! No more forfeits. If someone can't make it, those present can multi-play. During the playoffs and HLT, players may double-play, but no player may triple-play. No player may play more than one 9-Ball Singles Match per night during the regular session, or during the playoffs or other HLT events.
- A player may play in each of the two 9-Ball Doubles Matches, as long as they have a different partner in each match. The same two players can only shoot together in one of the two 9-Ball Doubles Matches.
- A 5-Match alternating format of 9-Ball Singles and 9-Ball Scotch Doubles, starting with Singles.
- Unlimited Coaching in all 9-Ball Scotch Doubles Matches ... Timeouts for the 9-Ball Singles Matches are the same as they are in regular 9-Ball.
- Each 9-Ball Scotch Doubles Match is limited to a combined maximum skill level of 10 points.
- "15-Point Limit" in the three 9-Ball Singles Matches (9-3-3, 6-6-3, 6-5-4, 5-5-5, etc.)
- **All players listed on an APA 9-Ball Scotch Doubles team must play at least FOUR 9-Ball Singles Matches with their Scotch Doubles team each session in order to advance to the playoffs. 9-Ball Doubles Matches do not count towards this requirement. **Players that are new to APA 9-Ball or have less than six (6) prior 9-Ball matches played are required to shoot a minimum of SIX APA 9-Ball Singles Matches with their Scotch Doubles team to advance to the playoffs. In short sessions it may be difficult for all six players to get in the required number of SINGLES matches, so please monitor everyone's matches played carefully.**
- Winning teams will advance to a Divisional playoff. The Divisional Champion will receive a Host Location Plaque, along with their choice of individual plaques or t-shirts. Both the Divisional Champions and the "Runner-Ups" will advance to the Tri-Annuals and receive patches and cash awards. The top "2" teams from the Tri-Annuals will receive trophies and advance to the Vegas Qualifier, held at the New Green Room in February of 2020. For a Spring or Summer Session Qualified Tri-Annual team to stay eligible to advance to the 9-Ball Scotch Doubles Vegas Qualifier, the team must stay active (with at least 3 original members) in a 9-Ball Scotch Doubles Division during the following sessions leading up to the Vegas Qualifier.
- **The Winning Team from our 2020 Scotch Doubles 9-Ball Vegas Qualifier will be awarded "3" Doubles Slots to play in the APA 9-Ball Doubles Championship (April/May 2020, in Las Vegas). They will also receive local awards, along with \$3,000 in Travel assistance.**
- To advance to the APA 9-Ball Doubles Championship, held in Las Vegas, a player must have a minimum of TWENTY 9-Ball scores in their record and all 20 scores must have been shot over the previous two years. To retain individual eligibility, each player must remain active on either a 9-Ball Scotch Doubles team, or a Traditional/Standard 9-Ball team during the Spring Session.
